The Hoggs have owned and operated numerous stores, the most recent being their New World Feilding store where they've been for 12 years.

Cameron and Nicole will move to the area ahead of their parents so they can operate the temporary supermarket that will open in early November in Tawa Mall while the adjacent supermarket is being redeveloped.



New World Tawa - the next steps...

New World is coming to Tawa with the redevelopment of the current supermarket and associated Tawa Mall between Oxford Street and Main Road.

Foodstuffs Wellington is redeveloping the supermarket into a full service New World to better match the needs of the Tawa community. We will increase the supermarket area by one third to 3,200 square metres and will re-open for customers in mid-2012.

Meanwhile, from early November, a temporary supermarket will operate from the mall as the redevelopment project takes place next door.

The store will be independently owned and operated as are all the stores in the Foodstuffs 100% New Zealand cooperative.

What's happening?

Stage 1 is underway to upgrade the structure of the mall premises and provide the temporary supermarket. This stage is due for completion in early November.

Stage 2 will be the full refurbishment of the existing supermarket from November 30 onwards and is due for completion mid-2012.





Tawa temporary supermarket will open in early November and will take up the western side of Tawa Mall. Cameron and Nicole Hogg will manage the store and are looking forward to meeting their customers.

The temporary supermarket will open prior to the current supermarket closure which happens at the end of November. We will carry a modest range of essential food needs including a limited range of key items from the departments
