**Health and Wellbeing**  
providing services which enhance the wellbeing of people



**Heritage and Environment**  
improving or revitalising the environment, culture or heritage



**Sport and Leisure**  
enhancing and increasing participation in physical sport, leisure activities and recreational pursuits. (This award is designed for those involved in 'running' the sport/leisure activity – coaching, administration, etc – as opposed to being a participant)



**Youth (15–24 years)**  
celebration and recognition of young people who provide outstanding service within the community of Tawa
